



SAFE WATER FOR LIFE AND DIGNITY - A GIFT OF LIFE!



A unique water project designed to provide safe water micro size villages in and around the city of Morogoro, Tanzania. Through local man power, materials and ingenuity water wells will be drilled, constructed and operated in areas where safe local drinking water is a dream. In collaboration with **Rotary International District 5970, Dubuque,**

Iowa; Salvatorian Priest and Brothers, The Franciscan Sisters of Dubuque Safe Water for Life and Dignity, schools and individual donors more than 30 wells are being dug with the potential of providing sanitary education to ensure that local residents will finally have safe drinking water for their families and village.

Objective of Project

To address the serious shortage of potable water in 30+ isolated mission communities around the town of Morogoro in central Tanzania.

Education through the RI Red - Bucket sanitary water program.

Develop a program model in order to provide similar water access in Southern Tanzania in the future-Salvatorian mission villages.

Type of Construction

- 🔍 Locate water source using SDS purchased water drill.
- 🔍 Purchase of concrete rings that will be placed in holes prepared by villagers and volunteers.

🔍 Number of rings is determined by water depth.

🔍 Upon completion of digging and ring insertion a concrete platform is built with pump.

🔍 Completion is done in approx. two weeks.

Ring Well Vs. Other Methods

🔍 Cost effective. Average cost per well \$4000 US and \$5000 US.

🔍 Material easily available.

🔍 Promotes self help concept in small amount of time.

🔍 Low cost allows for further outreach to other desperate villages vs. more elaborate technologies.

🔍 Ideal for small communities without electrical resources.
