

# A VIRTUAL TOUR OF THE SALVATORIAN ARCHIVES



The USA Province Archives of the Society of the Divine Savior are housed in the top three stories of the tall tower of St. Pius X Parish in Wauwatosa, Wisconsin. The church is not far from our province's main offices on Hi Mount Blvd in Milwaukee.

Salvatorians began the parish in 1953 and its ministries are provided by all three branches of the Salvatorian Family: the priests and Brothers, the Sisters, and the Lay Salvatorians.

The Archives were brought to the parish in 1986 from two main places: the province's main offices and the former Salvatorian Monastery in St. Nazianz, Wisconsin, which closed that year.
