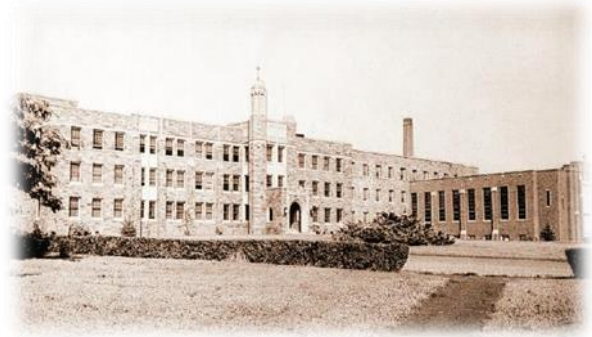
The presentation on this DVD contains over 300 pictures from the photo collections in the Salvatorians' USA Province Archives.
